On one hand the University ‘BAU International University, Batumi’, LEPL, (I/N 445434888 (hereinafter - „The University”) represented by----- and on the other hand the student of faculty of ----- (hereinafter “the Student”) conclude the following agreement on:

Art 1. The subject of the Agreement

1.1. The subject of the agreement is regulation of the relationship between the University and the student.

Art 2. The rights and obligations of Parties

2.1. The parties enjoy the rights granted under Laws of Georgia and bylaws, the University Charter and the regularions.

2.2. The student having acknowlegthed the Charter, the Regulations, «payment rules» and relevant faculty regulations uploaded on the University website, shall:

- a) Perform conscientiously his/her duties in connection with his/her studies; meet the requirement under the University Charter and By laws, the faculty regulations and various acts (orders, decisions, resolutions);
- b) Take care of the university property, maintain its qualitative and quantitavie status;
- c) Fulfill dully other obligations under this agreement and the applicable laws;
- d) Become familiar with the amendments to the University Acts mentioned in this agreement and/or the acts related to the student, from the information board of the relevant faculty and / or web-page;
- e) Check regularly an email registered at his/her name by the Univresity to receive notifications or/and acts sent from the University;

2.3. The University shall provide the student with:

- a) quality education;
- b) participation in the scientific research;
- c) necessary material and technical facilities;
- d) the right to take part in election of the faculty and the university management bodies;
- e) the right to be involved in the university staff evaluation process.

Art 3. The tuition fee

- 3.1. The program tuition fee (for an academic year) is ----- GEL.
- 3.2. The student pays tuition fee at the service banking institutions of the the University in line with the approved «Tuition fee payment regulations»;
- 3.3. **The start and end of the semester as well as the period of academic and administrative registration are defined in** the the legal acts, which are published on the website of the University;
- 3.4. «Tuition fee payment regulations» indicated in this artile may change with the decision of the partners' meeting.
- 3.5. The tuition fee in foreign currency is paid in the accrual day exchange rate of GEL to foreign currencies determined by the National Bank of Georgia;
- 3.6. If a subject (credits) is to be retaken, a students covers the tuition fee according to the number of credits to be taken, in line with the requirements of «Tuition fee payment regulations»;
- 3.7. If as a result of failure to fulfill or improper fulfilment of academic or/and financial liability or other obligation the student status is terminated, the paid tuition is not refunded to student. In case of enrolment via recovery procedure he/she pays the tuition fee for the current academic year.
- 3.8. If the university student's status termination act, caused by a student's fault (financial liability, sabbatical leave, etc), is recognized invalid, the tuition fee for the relevant edicational program is determined in the amount stated for the recovery period.

Art 4. The contract term

- 4.1. This agreement is valid for ----- and remains in force till its termination;
- 4.2. Basis for agreement termination is cease of student status;
- 4.3. Grounds to cease university student's status are:
 - a) Personal statement;
 - b) Mobility to other higher education institutions;
 - c) Expiry of the educational program, except the cases defined by the academic council;
 - d) The cases determined by the University charter, bylaws and other acts;
 - e) 5 years since the University student status is terminated;
- 4.4. In case of a student status recovery procedure, change of a faculty/educational program or its price, the requirements of the latest university acts are in force together with the requirements of this agreement.

Art. 5. Special Terms

- 5.1 The status is terminated upon the rules and terms defined by the University Charter, the Regulations and other acts when student is in sabbatical leave, sick, in foreign country to study or has financial debt.

Art. 6. Other Terms

- 6.1. The cases not considered under this agreement are regulated by the current legislation;
- 6.2. The terms of the agreement can be amended according to the legislation;

6.3. In case of dispute arising out of this agreement, limitation period shall be counted from the date of publication of the act of the status termination period.

Art. 7. Party requisites

7.1. This Agreement is made in Georgian and English languages in two copies of equal legal power;

7.2. Each copy of the agreement is kept at the parties;
